Did You Know?

Movie Trivia Facts

The cat in *The Godfather* was a stray found on the set. Director Francis Ford Coppola handed the cat to Marlon Brando at the beginning of the scene. The cat purred so loud in his lap that the film crew was afraid he would drown out the dialogue.

Those green symbols trailing down in *The Matrix* are not complicated algorithms. A production designer scanned symbols from his wife's sushi cookbooks, then manipulated them to create the iconic "code".

In *Jurassic Park*, in many of the scenes the velociraptor "communications" were created using horse breathing sounds and goose hisses.

E.T. and *Poltergeist* started from the same script by John Sayles entitled **Night Skies**, a darker story. Steven Spielberg wanted a more family-friendly story and created *E.T. Extra Terrestrial*. He later created *Poltergeist*.

Michael Myer's mask in *Halloween* was created by combining a clown mask and a Captain Kirk *Star Trek* mask, spray painted it white and adjusted the mask and hair to create a terrifying mask.

Toy Story's Woody was originally a ventriloquist dummy written as a sarcastic bully trying to rally other toys against Buzz. Luckily, the studio transformed him into a more lovable character.

Gone With the Wind's fire scene was old sets being burned. The filmmakers had to get rid of the old sets to make room for the new movie's scenery anyway, so burning them and filming it as "Atlanta" going down in flames accomplished both.

Jaws' most famous line was ad-libbed. The line was actually "You're gonna need a bigger boat," not "we're" as it's often misquoted. The line wasn't in the original script but was an inside joke among the *Jaws* crew, teasing the stingy producers for picking a support boat that was too small to hold the equipment. Actor Roy Schneider ad-libbed the line throughout filming, but the one kept in the final cut became one of the most remembered movie quotes of all time.
