Moody Uniform Policy

1. Types and colors of the student uniform:

<u>Shirts/Tops</u> (Colors will be Red, White, Navy Blue, and Light Blue)

- Solid color, polo style shirts without any logos, designs or writing.
- Moody logo T-shirts.

- Solid color long sleeve or turtleneck shirts in red, white, navy blue, light blue or black may be worn <u>under</u> uniform shirts.

Bottoms (Colors will be Khaki, Navy Blue, and Black)

- Pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, or Capri pants.

- Leggings can be worn with skirts and jumpers.

- All bottoms must follow the Manatee County Student Code of Conduct. Items must have a proper fit at the waist and must be the appropriate length: 2/3 of the leg from the waist to the knee. Please refer to the Student Code of Conduct booklet provided by the school district for more information.

- Sweatpants are not permitted.
- NO denim or blue jeans are permitted.
- Oversized, baggie, extremely tight or ill-fitting clothing is not permitted.

2. Optional articles of attire:

- Students are expected to follow the Code of Conduct in regards to footwear. Shoes need to be properly fitting and should not cause any distraction or safety concerns.

- No flip-flops, backless sandals, or backless shoes.

- Sunglasses, hats, visors, and bandanas are not permitted on campus unless an activity is scheduled that would allow for their use.

3. Compliance:

- Our uniform policy is mandatory and it is expected that all students will wear the school uniform on a daily basis. Parents are responsible for enforcing Moody's Uniform Policy.

<u>If a student comes to school out of uniform, the following actions may take place:</u> The student will be required to change into the proper uniform before entering class.
