Rationale for delivering the instruction in the courses and grades selected above

Selah Freedom- Sex Lies and Media Training: students were educated on Human trafficking and were presented scenarios on how students can be tricked into Trafficking. The delivery method was whole group classroom instruction by a Selah Freedom representative who provided a video, and PowerPoint with discussion. The presentation was a face to face presentation and lasted one hour. Presenters spent the entire day with the all the enrolled students in various courses that meet the Health Standard.

A21 Curriculum- Bodies are not Commodities: students were presented with topics related to the history of human trafficking and how it evolved to modern day trafficking. Students reviewed ways they can protect themselves through play-based activities videos and articles. Techniques were presented on to how empower children, to champion their young voices, and to show that they are more than capable of making informed decisions to protect themselves and others.

Chosen Video: Teachers presented the PBS Videos/Chosen Video and engaged in class discussion. The Chosen Video presents a true story of two teen girls tricked by traffickers. Brianna, 18, was a star student, cheerleader and waitress eager to break out of her small town to attend college in the big city. Lacy, 13, enjoyed church and school but struggled to help care for her siblings while her stepfather was deployed and mother worked to support the family. Brianna and Lacy share how traffickers used manipulation to lure them into the world of sex trafficking
