



# RETURN TO SCHOOL MEAL PLAN FOR STUDENTS



## SAFE SERVING

- All Food & Nutrition Services (FNS) employees will receive safety training.
- Face coverings and gloves are required to be worn while preparing and serving food.
- All serving areas will be cleaned and sanitized before, during and after meal service.
- FNS will follow all SDMC procedures for entering the building and temperature taking.
- Only essential staff will be permitted in the kitchen to minimize risk.



## MEAL SERVICE

- FNS will partner with the administration of each school to develop a meal service plan that will meet the needs of the schools.
- Food will be served to students in closed containers and packaged together for ease of service.
- Packaged utensils and condiments will be provided with meals.
- Students will be served at alternative locations including at carts & kiosks where appropriate.
- Take home meals will be available for hybrid students for the school days they do not attend in person.
- Drive thru meals will be available for pick up for Distance Learners.
- Students enrolled with a virtual school are not eligible to participate in the FNS program.



## BADGING

- It is imperative that students use their badges to minimize touching.



## CELEBRATIONS

- It is recommend that classroom parties using outside food is suspended as well as use of outside food fundraising.

- Menus will be limited and will focus on student favorites.
- FREE breakfast will continue to be provided to all students.
- Limited A la carte options will be available.
- Students at Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) schools will continue to have free lunch.
