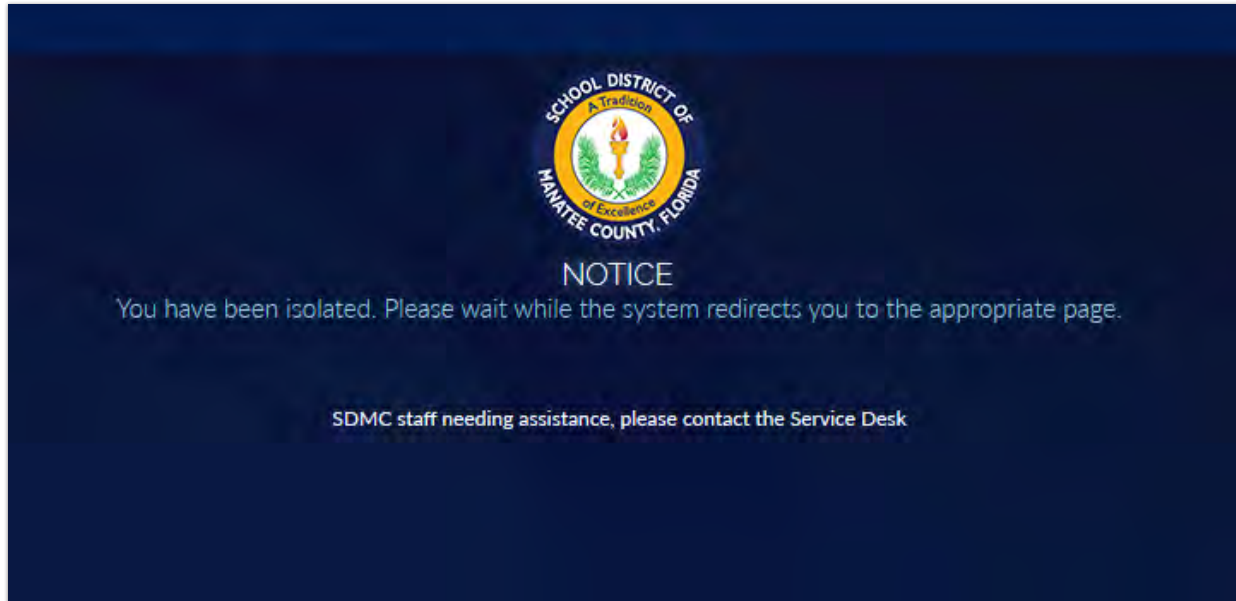

To connect using your own device: Join the ManateeConnect wireless network


- ◆ Search available Wi-Fi networks.

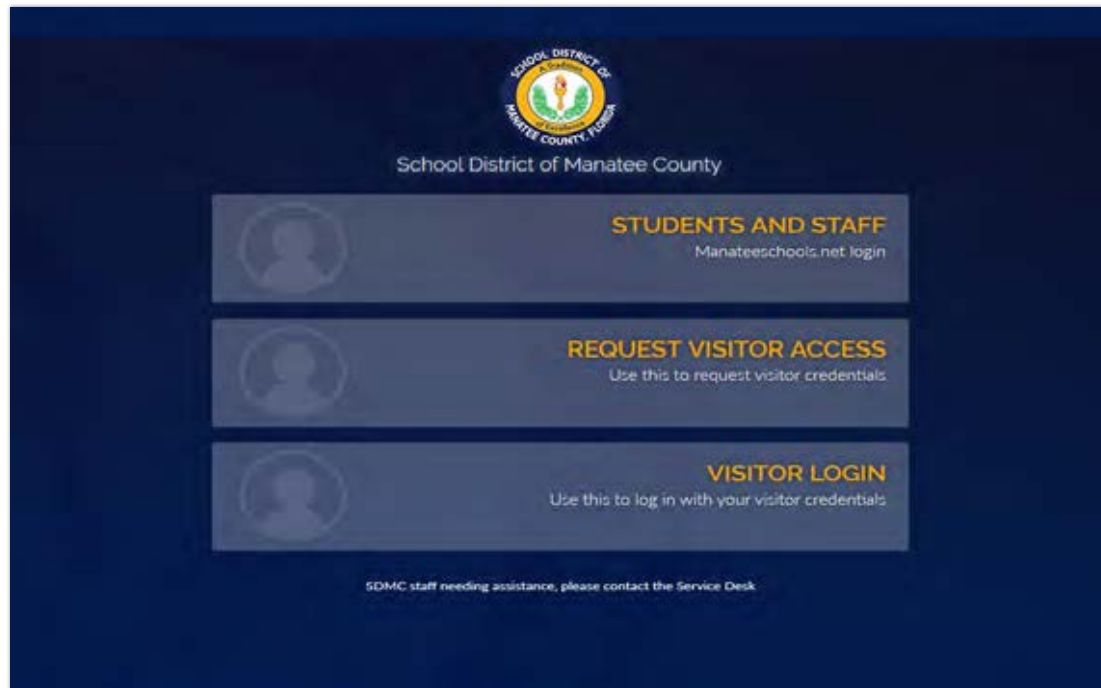



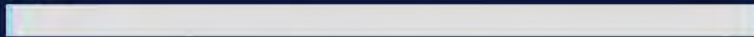
