



BRMS Daily COVID-19 Safety Protocols*

Seven Steps to Safety!

Your child's safety is our utmost priority! Here are the steps we will take to ensure safety for hybrid learners & traditional (five-day) learners on a daily basis:

Step 1: 6 Entry points-



Entry point	6 th , 7 th or 8 th hybrid or traditional
Car rider door @ front gate	A-L (car riders, walkers & bikers)
Car rider door @ Bldg 6 front	M-Z (car riders, walkers & bikers)
Bus lane @ Bldg 1	A-L
Bus lane @ Bldg 2	M-Z

Safety features: All students must wear masks when entering the buildings, practice social distancing, and adhere to random temperature checks. Grab & go breakfast cart will be available at entry points. Students showing symptoms will be sent to faculty lounge (adjacent to cafeteria)-parents will be contacted to pick up student & the student will remain there until picked up. All students will complete Student Covid-19 agreement during zero hour/1st period.

Step 2: Assigned social distancing areas- (Students will eat breakfast in these areas)

- 6th grade: gym/multi-purpose room for those eating breakfast first
- 7th grade: cafeteria
- 8th grade: courtyard

Safety features: Signs, social distancing & extra garbage cans for trash disposal.

Step 3: Dismissal for zero hour/1st period-

- Students will be dismissed by sections & instructed to social distance.
- Students will report to zero hour/1st period for announcements & to retrieve Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Each student will receive one pack of five masks & a safety shield.

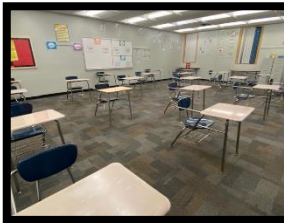
Safety features: Masks, face shields, storage area for supplies to be kept at school

Step 4: In class-

Traditional



Hybrid



- Teachers will spray desks with cleaning solution as classes are dismissed.
- Students entering class will wipe their desks.
- Students will clean hands using hand sanitizer before taking their seat.
- Outside breaks will be granted at the teacher's discretion.
- In tech classes, teachers will be given keyboard covers, which can easily be cleaned.

Safety features: School Board approved cleaning solution, gloves, hand sanitizer dispensers in every classroom, single fold paper towels, and protective covering for keyboards

Step 5: In between classes-



- Coordinated movement by teachers in each hallway.
- Hallway movement-Stay to the right & six feet apart (social distancing).
- Stairs-one way only
 - Front stairs-up only
 - Back stairs-down only

Safety features: Directional signs, social distance

Step 6: Lunch-



- 3 separate eating areas-cafeteria, picnic area & multi-purpose room for social distancing.
- 4 different lunches to accommodate social distancing.
- Only one side of each cafeteria table will be used.
- Students will sanitize hands as they leave class & will have an opportunity to use soap & water at their discretion.
- Students may wear shields when masks are down in order to eat safely.
- Dividers set up for social distancing.

Safety features: Signs, hand sanitizing stations, extra portable serving lines for social distancing, face shields, & HVAC circulates in fresh air.

Step 7: Dismissal-

- Students report to 8th hour/1st period to clean & store shields.
- Students who sign out early will leave their shield in the office.
- Staggered release by building.
- Coordinated movement by teachers.
- Students exit the building through the same doors they entered.
- Bus waiting areas will be assigned by bus number.
- Car rider waiting area will be expanded.

Safety features: School district approved cleaning solution for shields, signs, and social distancing.
