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- Millage Referendum Presentation (Mike Barber and Kevin Chapman)
 - 2018 passed the referendum and every four years it must be renewed. It must be on a general election.
 - o Amendment number 7 on the ballet.
 - 1 mil funded has brought the school district to what it is. We went from around 47 in the state to about 27 and our test scores have improved. We have increased the number of A schools in the county.
 - o ½ of the millage goes to supporting the salary of our educators and school-based employees. The district doesn't get the mileage.
 - The rest goes to stem and robotics.
 - Visual performing arts are included.
 - Sarasota has had a millage for 20 years.
 - We are now able to be competitive with Sarasota.
 - o Added to the millage this year.
 - Safety and Security
 - Early learning. K-2 reading proficiency.
 - Athletics
 - Manatee Chamber Offices has yard signs for free
 - The millage rate is staying the same. 1 million on your home.
 - Can't go higher but can go lower.
 - What if it doesn't pass
 - \$78 million needs to be found. No alethic, no visual arts programs. (worst case).
 - o 26/27- rezoning will happen and start times will change
 - o There is a report on what the millage has been spent on.

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- School Improvement Plan Renewal & Approval
 - o Areas of focus or SIP (Student Improvement Plan)
 - This plan is sent for review and then sent back to the school once approved.
 - BRE Learning gains in ELA will be 65% or higher, with a focus on L25 in grades 3-5.
 - BRE learning gains in Math will be 70% or higher, with a focus on L25 in grades 3-5.
 - BRE level 1 on FAST reading and math PM3 will be 10% or less (k-2)
 - BRE proficiency in ELA will be 75% or higher, with a focus on third grade.
 - This does get published for a deeper review.
