

Nov 1 Meeting Began at 6:05 PM

September and October minutes were approved. Motion by Alejos and Second by Dunston.

Principal Scarbrough showed a vimeo presentation on the millage referendum.

Assistant Principal Cochran discussed the **Canes Promotion Plan**. The CPP is for students not coming to school and who have low GPA/credit deficiencies. MHS traditionally graduates 85-90 percent of its senior class but expect to dip to 80 percent because of COVID. Seventeen students currently enrolled in CPP and expect the first graduate within the next week. Target enrollment is 30 students by the end of 1<sup>st</sup> semester.

Principal Scarbrough and AP Cochran discussed the Dual Enrollment program additions for the coming year. The school will partner with Yamaha on small engine repair program beginning 2022-2023. Discussing ongoing partnership with SCF and USF-Manasota. Parents asked about re-starting the Culinary Arts program and Engineering Academy. The Engineering Academy is in the emerging status and the culinary arts building is undergoing roof repairs.
