### **A. REGULATIONS**

A. Students must identify, research and create a 5-10 minute presentation using a visual and/or prop explaining one of the following:

- A specific environmental problem such as **Air pollution: How is it affecting the environment?**
- A specific medical problem such as **New generation being affected by scoliosis**
- Invent an invention the solves the problem such as losing your cell phone.

### **B. DOCUMENTATION-**

- A bibliography should be attached to the back of the poster or handed in at the beginning of the presentation.
