PLAN FOR COLLEGE

*** Consider College Options and make a plan *now***

4-year university/college? 2-year college? 2+2 option? Technical College? Now is the time to decide what is right for you and take action. Two opportunities to help you plan for college:

- **MHS College Information Night for Seniors – Thursday, September 7th** at 6:30pm in the MHS Davis Theater. Get lots of information to help you plan for and apply to colleges.
- **MHS College Fair** – Our fair is Monday, September 11th during the morning. Come prepared to ask questions, speak to college representatives and learn about college options.

*** SAT/ACT Testing** - If you are taking the tests this fall, be sure to register online before the deadlines. The list of test dates and deadlines is posted on the MHS website and on the Class of 2024 Schoology page.

APPLY TO COLLEGE

*** Complete your College Applications** - Seniors applying to 4-year universities should be completing their college applications this fall. BE AWARE OF DEADLINES! Read application instructions carefully. Go to the college website for details on how/when to apply.

*** Interested in SCF?** - Seniors interested in attending State College of Florida (SCF) after graduation may apply in mid-October. Check the Class of 2024 Schoology page for when the SCF rep will be here for application workshops.

*** Interested in MTC?**- Seniors interested in MTC can apply starting in February 2024. In the meantime, visit the MTC website to learn more about their different programs and Open House dates.

PAY FOR COLLEGE

*** Complete the FAFSA** – but not until *January!* Stay tuned for more information about this very important application! ALL seniors should complete it – it is the key to getting money to help pay for college!

*** Complete the Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA)**- which includes Bright Futures and other state grants for students who will attend college/technical school in Florida. The application opens **October 1st**.

*** Apply for private scholarships.** Check the list on the MHS website – on the College and Career Center page. Other resources are the College Board and Fast Web. There are thousands of scholarships for high school students – apply!
