REGISTRATION PROCESS

1. Students will receive their registration forms during their 10th grade History teacher. These forms are due back to your teacher no later than **THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 2025**.

Note: Work closely with your teachers to discuss correct selections and refer to the Curriculum Guide on the MHS website (Guidance Page) to make sure you are meeting pre-requisites for courses.

Note: Counselors *will not* be meeting with students to answer registration questions now (See #2). If students have questions, they need to write them down, and ask them when they meet with their counselor one-on-one. Again, this is why students need to work closely with their teachers during this process.

2. Once the requests have been entered, **counselors will meet individually with each student**, during the week of **March 3, 2025** to discuss appropriate placements, graduation status, answer questions and make any adjustments discussed between the student/counselor.

3. In May, students will receive a copy of their updated requests. This will be the last opportunity to make final request changes.

4. Please remember that once the school year begins, we will follow the Schedule Change Policy as stated in the Curriculum Guide.

OPTIONS FOR JUNIOR YEAR

1. Continue to attend MHS for 7 periods each day.

2. **MHS and Part Time Dual Enrollment Off Campus:** Example: Students take 4 classes at MHS and 3 classes at SCF. The three classes at SCF may not affect a student's schedule at MHS. It is, therefore, recommended that an SCF class start time be at noon or later. To qualify, students must meet Application, GPA and Testing requirements (See Curriculum Guide). DEADLINES are strictly adhered to. Students interested in this option must attend the mandatory DE Meeting with their parent/guardian. Information for this meeting will be posted in Schoology, on the MHS website, and through Connect Ed messages.

3. **Full Time Dual Enrollment Off Campus (Accelerated Dual Enrollment):** Students may attend SCF full time junior AND senior year. You are still a MHS student, but you take all your classes at SCF. To qualify, students must meet Application, GPA and Testing requirements (See Curriculum Guide). DEADLINES are strictly adhered to. Students interested in this option must attend the mandatory DE Meeting with their parent/guardian. Information for this meeting will be posted in Schoology, on the MHS website, and through Connect Ed messages.

4. **Manatee Technical College:** Students attending MTC fulltime will attend Monday-Friday, 8:00AM-3:00PM. Students attending MTC part-time will attend MTC Monday-Friday, 8:00AM-11:00AM and will be able to return to MHS for 6th and 7th periods. Information will soon be posted on the MHS website.
