REGISTRATION PROCESS

1. Students will receive their registration forms from their 11th grade US History teacher. **These forms are due back to your teacher no later than FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2024.**

Note: Work closely with your teachers to discuss correct selections and refer to the Curriculum Guide on the MHS website (Guidance Page) to make sure you are meeting pre-requisites for courses.

Note: Counselors **will not** be meeting with students to answer registration questions (See #2). If students have questions, they need to write them down, and then when they meet with their counselor one-on-one, the questions will be addressed at that time. Again, this is why students need to work closely with their teachers during this process.

2. Once the requests have been entered, **counselors will meet individually with each student**, during the week of **March 4, 2024**, to discuss appropriate placements, graduation status, answer questions and make any adjustments discussed between the student/counselor.

3. In May, students will receive a copy of their updated requests. This will be the last opportunity to make final request changes.

4. Please remember that once the school year begins, we will follow the Schedule Change Policy as stated in the Curriculum Guide.

OPTIONS FOR SENIOR YEAR

1. Continue to attend MHS for 7 periods each day.

2. **Combination of MHS/OJT: OJT is On the Job Training** where students have an opportunity to earn high school credits for their work experience. Students must enroll in an OJT course on campus, and then for every 7.5 hours/week a student works, they may be released from 1 period at school (Ex. If you work 15 hours/week, you can have 2 periods off campus). Students are only accepted into the program through an application process and there are strict rules/requirements the students must adhere to.

3. **MHS and Part Time Dual Enrollment Off Campus:** Example: Students take 4 classes at MHS and 3 classes at SCF. The three classes at SCF may not affect a student's schedule at MHS. It is, therefore, recommended that an SCF class start time be at noon or later. To qualify, students must meet Application, GPA and Testing requirements (See Curriculum Guide). DEADLINES are strictly adhered to. Students interested in this option must attend the mandatory DE Meeting with their parent/guardian on February 22 at 6:00 pm in the MHS Cafeteria. Information for this meeting will be posted in Schoology, on the MHS website, and through Connect Ed messages.

4. **Full Time Dual Enrollment Off Campus (Early Admission):** Students may attend SCF/USF full time senior year. You are still a MHS student, but you take 4 classes at SCF/USF each semester and none at MHS. To qualify, students must meet Application, GPA and Testing requirements (See Curriculum Guide). DEADLINES are strictly adhered to. Students interested in this option must attend the mandatory DE Meeting with their parent/guardian on February 22 at 6:00 pm in the MHS Cafeteria. Information for this meeting will be posted in Schoology, on the MHS website, and through Connect Ed messages.

5. **Manatee Technical College:** Students attending MTC full-time will attend Monday-Friday, 8:00AM-3:00PM. Students attending MTC part-time will attend MTC Monday-Friday, 8:00AM-11:00AM and will return to MHS for 6th and 7th periods. Please see the MHS website for requirements, available programs, and application.

I have carefully chosen my courses based on graduation, college entrance, NCAA and Bright Futures requirements (review Curriculum Guide). I understand that once school begins my schedule will not be changed.
