

## SCHOOL YEAR

2020/2021 is divided into two semesters, each 90 days in duration. School will be in session for 180 days for students and 196 days for faculty.

## LENGTH OF CLASS PERIOD

Manatee High School is a traditional seven class period day. The duration of each class is 50 minutes.

## UNITS OF CREDIT

One unit of credit is assigned for each course, two semesters in duration. One half unit of credit is assigned for each course that meets for one semester.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

Manatee High School per Florida State Statute requires 24 credits for a standard diploma, a passing score on the FSA-ELA as well as a passing score on the Algebra 1 EOC, and a cumulative 2.0 unweighted GPA.
