This letter is to inform you that you currently are *not on track for an on-time graduation*. You are missing courses/credits required to graduate. Additionally, a minimum 2.0 GPA is required to graduate.

Southeast High School offers several options to earn the missing courses/credits. Options include but may not be limited to Florida Virtual School (FLVS) and/or a sixweek summer school program here at SEHS.

You have been selected to participate in the Summer School program at Southeast High School through Edgenuity. Summer School starts June 7, 2021 and ends July 15, 2021. Classes are Monday through Thursday from 8 a.m.—12 p.m. Free breakfast (arrive by 7:45 a.m.) and lunch (12:00 p.m.) are included, and this year transportation will be included as well.

You must work daily and show progress in your Edgenuity class(es) to stay enrolled in the Summer School program. Failure to do so may result in your removal from the program.
