Attendance

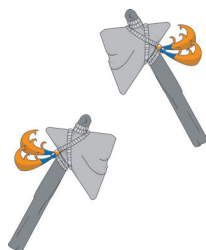

Bookkeeping

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Manatee County Public Schools is committed to providing quality instruction for all students and does so by employing the most qualified individuals to teach and support each student in the classroom. All educators in the state of Florida are monitored to ensure that they meet certification and training requirements as mandated by law. All our teachers are certified to teach, although some of them are currently out-of-field and are working on additional areas of certification.

You have the right to know the professional qualifications of the teachers who instruct your child. Per Florida Statute 1012.42, when a teacher is assigned teaching duties out of the field in which the teacher is certified, the parents of all students in the class shall be notified in writing.

Federal law allows you to ask for certain information about your child's teachers and requires us to give you this information in a timely manner if you ask for it. Según el número 1012.42 del estatuto de la Florida, cuando se asigna un maestro para deberes fuera de área de certificación en el que el maestro es certificado, los padres de los estudiantes en la clase se notificará por escrito. Según No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB), también estamos obligados a notificar a los padres cuando su hijo ha sido impartido por cuatro o más semanas consecutivas por un maestro no cualificado en la área de certificación para esa clase.

Escuelas públicas del Condado de Manatee se compromete a proporcionar instrucción de calidad para todos los estudiantes y lo hace mediante el empleo de los individuos más calificados para enseñar y apoyar a cada estudiante. Todos nuestros maestros están certificados para enseñar, aunque algunos de ellos están actualmente fuera de área de certificación o no calificados y están trabajando en otras áreas de certificación. Usted tiene el derecho de conocer las cualificaciones profesionales de los maestros que instruyen a su hijo. Ley federal le permite a pedir cierta información sobre su hijo y nos obliga a darle esta información en forma oportuna si lo pides.
