





Southeast High School Course Request Information for 2024-2025

Course Request Timeline

- ▶ Monday, March 4th to Friday, March 8th
 - ▶ Students will receive Course Request Form in 1st period on Monday, March 4th.
 - ▶ Each day students will pick up and drop off request forms in 1st period.
 - ▶ Students not returning to their 1st period at the end of the day when released will be considered skipping.
 - ▶ Students turn in white copies of the student request forms to their 7th period teachers on Friday, March 8th. Students keep the yellow copies for their records.

Course Request Guidelines

- ▶ Review the courses in the curriculum guide and discuss options with your teachers.
- ▶ Students should also discuss course selections with parent(s)/guardian(s).
- ▶ Each of your core subject area teachers (English, Math, Science, and Social Studies) will recommend the next level course you should take. (9th grade English teachers will recommend for Social Studies.)
- ▶ Choose Six (6) electives in priority order.
- ▶ Visit the counselors during all lunches in the Media Center Monday, March 4th – Friday, March 8th to discuss any questions or concerns.

What is a Prerequisite?

- ▶ If a course has a prerequisite, that means you must complete a specific course or earn a minimum grade in previous coursework prior to being permitted to enroll in the class.
- ▶ Example: To enroll in the Principles of Entrepreneurship course, you must first complete the Digital Information Technology course.
- ▶ Example: To enroll in a Spanish II course, you must earn a “C” or better in Spanish I.
- ▶ Prerequisites are italicized after the course title in the Curriculum Guides.

Academic Courses and 10th Grade Required Course

► Core teachers will recommend core classes based on graduation requirements, course history, current grades, and test scores. (9th grade English teachers will recommend for Social Studies.)

► All Non-IB 10th grade students will be required to take Personal Finance and Money Management/Economics which is a graduation requirement.

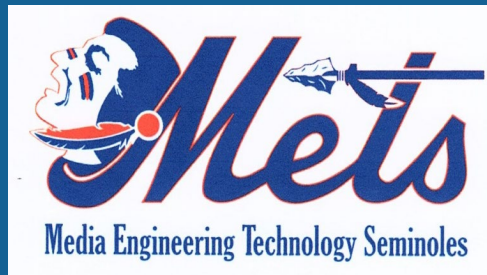

Schedule Change Policy

Students are expected to honor their commitments and to attend and complete the courses for which they registered during the registration period. Therefore, schedule change requests will only be considered for the following reasons:

1. The student already earned the credit for the course.
2. The student failed to meet the prerequisite for the course.
3. The student has too many or not enough courses.
4. There was a clerical error.


Counselors will be in the Media Center during all three lunches Monday - Friday during registration week if you have any questions or need applications for specific elective courses.

Dual Enrollment (DE) Eligibility

- ▶ Students interested in DE courses must work closely with their school counselor.
- ▶ Academically motivated for college-level work.
- ▶ Unweighted GPA must be a 3.0 for SCF.
- ▶ Weighted GPA of 3.5 or higher for USF.
- ▶ Acceptable test scores (as determined by SCF or USF) on the SAT, ACT or post-secondary readiness test (PERT).
- ▶ All DE requirements must be met by May 1st, even if the DE course is offered during the spring semester.



Dual Enrollment & Early Admissions

- ▶ The Bloomberg DE course can be taken on the SEHS campus through USF.
 - ▶ DE courses can be taken at the SCF and/or USF campus.
 - ▶ Juniors and Seniors may enroll in courses at the SCF and/or USF campus on a part-time basis.
 - ▶ Seniors may enroll in courses at the SCF and/or USF campus on a part-time or full-time basis.
 - ▶ Rising Juniors can attend SCF full time with Accelerated Dual Enrollment (ADE).
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Dual Enrollment (DE) Eligibility



- ▶ Any student who is interested in attending MTC must complete an enrollment application and receive a signature from their high school counselor.
- ▶ Students must be rising juniors or seniors and be at least 16 years of age.
- ▶ Students must have an unweighted cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- ▶ Students must have passed all state required assessments for graduation.
- ▶ The deadline for application to attend MTC is early April.

Advanced Placement (AP)

- ▶ Students interested in AP courses must have teacher approval. Discuss with teacher to see if you are “ready” for AP.
- ▶ If a scheduling conflict arises, you will be contacted by a counselor or administration to select another course.
- ▶ You are required to take the end of year AP Exam.



Grade Forgiveness Policy

- ▶ If a student has been unsuccessful (D or F) in a course, he or she will not be scheduled back into the course at SEHS.
- ▶ Students must register through Florida Virtual School to recover a credit (www.flvs.net) or attend Summer School.
- ▶ Students need to obtain approval from their counselor before they can begin an FLVS course.
- ▶ 11th & 12th Grade students may be eligible to take Credit Recovery during the school day.
- ▶ If the student receives a C or higher in the repeated course, the original failing grade will not be calculated into the student's GPA but will still appear on the transcript.

Fine/Performing/Practical Arts Requirement


- ▶ All students must earn a Fine/Performing/Practical Arts credit for graduation.
- ▶ Some courses that satisfy the Fine Art requirement at SEHS include:
 - ▶ 2D Studio Art
 - ▶ Acting 1
 - ▶ Theatre, Cinema, and Film
 - ▶ Band
 - ▶ Orchestra
 - ▶ Keyboard
 - ▶ Chorus
 - ▶ Eurhythmics
 - ▶ Digital Video Technology
 - ▶ Digital Media
 - ▶ Digital Design
 - ▶ Digital Information Technology
 - ▶ Applied Engineering Technology
 - ▶ Culinary 2
 - ▶ Principles of Entrepreneurship
 - ▶ Marketing Essentials


HOPE Waiver

- ▶ A student can waive the HOPE requirement in one of two ways:
 1. Participate two seasons in a sport at the Junior Varsity or Varsity level.
 2. Complete two years of JROTC. This will waive the full credit in HOPE and the full credit in Fine Arts.
- ▶ Please see your counselor for the HOPE Waiver!

Specialized Courses

- ▶ Some courses at SEHS require a special application and/or require an audition.
 - ▶ Instrumental Techniques and Eurhythmics are courses that require auditions. Make sure to see Ms. Vella to find out more about the audition process.
 - ▶ OJT, AVID, SGA, and Executive Internship are courses that require applications. Applications can be found on the SEHS website.
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Executive Intern (Office Aide)

- ▶ This is a student aide course that enables students to develop:
 - ▶ decision-making skills
 - ▶ personal and job-related skills
 - ▶ interpersonal skills
 - ▶ leadership potential
 - ▶ individual responsibility
 - ▶ Minimum GPA of a 2.5 or higher.
 - ▶ Juniors and Seniors only.
 - ▶ No major discipline (OSS, multiple ISS, etc.) or excessive absences.
 - ▶ Application is available on the SEHS website
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On-The-Job Training (OJT)

- ▶ Students must be employed at the start of the 2024 -2025 school year.
- ▶ Must be a junior or senior to enroll in OJT.
- ▶ Students must have teacher approval and must complete an OJT application.
- ▶ The OJT advisor is Mr. Nelles in room 761.
- ▶ Application is available on the SEHS website
- ▶ OJT spots are limited.
- ▶ Turn in the application ASAP in order to be considered.
