Parking Privileges Agreement Form

2019-2020

1. Qualified Drivers:

- A. **To be eligible for a parking permit, the driver of the vehicle must be a Junior or Senior registered to attend LRHS and have a valid driver's license.**
- B. **All drivers must obtain a LRHS parking permit to park at LRHS.** MTC and SFC permits do not qualify for parking at LRHS. Parking will be divided into three student categories: Seniors, OJT/MTI/SCF, and General. Your vehicle will only occupy one parking space.
- C. All permits must be purchased through the LRHS office and are not transferable to another driver. Any driver withdrawing from LRHS must turn in their parking permit on their last day.
- D. All drivers must have a current Application, printed copy of Parent & Student Driver's License, Insurance card, and Registration of the vehicle parked on campus on file at the school.
- E. All student parking permits cost \$50.00 and are good during school hours (7:00 am – 3:00 pm) August 12, 2019 to May 28, 2020. Parking permits are **non-transferable to another student and non-refundable.**
- F. All vehicle parking at LRHS will have assigned parking space. Your parking permit number will match your parking space.
- G. All Student Debt, Fees, Fines, overdue Library and Textbook must be cleared before a Parking Permit is issued.

2. Application Procedures:

- A. Students are to complete the attached application, have a parent or guardian sign the application form, and clear any fees or fines. Applications are accepted in the bookkeeping office, room 110 and 126 in the main administration building. Payment may be paid by cash or check. Application and all requirements must be completed before permit is issued.
- B. Lakewood Ranch High School reserves the right to deny any student the privilege of parking based on their attendance, tardies or disciplinary history at school.

THIS SHALL SERVE AS NOTICE THAT LAKEWOOD RANCH HIGH SCHOOL AND THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF MANATEE COUNTY ARE NOT LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGE OR VANDALISM TO A VEHICLE, THEFT OF VEHICLE TO OR FROM VEHICLES PARKED ON THE PROPERTY.

3. PARKING LOT RULES:

The student hereby applies to LRHS of Manatee County School District (MCSD) for a student parking permit good for one parking space. In making this application, I understand, acknowledge, and agree to the following conditions as a prerequisite to, and in consideration for, the issuance of a student parking permit that authorizes me to drive and park on the LRHS school campus.

- A. I agree that it is a privilege, not a right, to drive or park on a LRHS school campus and to have a LRHS student parking permit. I agree that if I fail to comply with MCSB policy, the policies of my school, and/or the conditions contained in this application, LRHS may immediately revoke my student parking permit and parking privilege.
- B. I agree that the student parking permit that I am issued is for one parking space and shall remain the property of LRHS and the MCSD.

- C. I understand that if I refuse to cooperate with the search of my vehicle pursuant to this agreement, LRHS may have the vehicle immediately towed or removed from the school campus at the owner's expense and will also result in disciplinary action.
- D. I agree that I am responsible for the contents of any vehicle I drive.
- E. I agree that the MCSD and its officers, agents, or employees, and any and all law enforcement personnel shall not be responsible and are released from any liability for any theft, loss, and/or damage to my vehicle while on any MCSD school campus, and I agree that the MCSD and all law enforcement agencies are hereby released and held harmless from all liability, claims or damages connected with the search of a vehicle on an MCSD school campus, or from the removal of a vehicle as provided above.
- F. **Any student leaving campus without permission or **transporting a student without permission** will lose their right to park at LRHS.**
- G. **Any student that has a drug or alcohol discipline infraction will lose the right to park at LRHS.**
- H. **Any student who has more than five (5) first period tardies, cumulative in the 2018-19 school year will incur a suspension of parking privileges at LRHS. School buses arrive on time. We expect our student drivers to do the same.**
- I. Minor infractions will be dealt with in accordance with student discipline using the parking lot referral.
- J. LAKEWOOD RANCH HIGH SCHOOL IS A CLOSED CAMPUS. Students must have their parent/guardian sign them in when late, or sign them out if leaving early in the attendance office.
- K. Safe driving procedures are to be followed at all times. The Speed Limit is five (5) miles per hour on campus. You are subject to being ticketed and losing your permit for an infraction.
- L. Loud and/or offensive music is NOT permitted.
- M. The school parking lot is a closed area of the campus from 7:00AM until school is dismissed. School personnel have the authority to stop, check, and verify information from any student in the parking lot.
- N. **Students must not sit in or on, or loiter around cars at any time.**
- O. Misuse of parking permits (putting your permit on an unauthorized vehicle or giving your permit to another student) is not permitted and may result in the loss of parking privileges.
- P. If a permit is lost, stolen, damaged, etc., a new permit must be obtained, and you must update your application. A \$5.00 fee will apply.
- Q. The parking permit must hang from the rearview mirror and be clearly visible through the windshield, If not visible a \$5. Parking fine will apply. NO EXCEPTIONS. The last 3 numbers of the parking permit number IS your parking space number.
- R. **Permits cannot be shared, given or sold to another student.**
- S. **Violation of parking lot rules and Students parking in an unauthorized space are subject to a \$5.00 fine for each occurrence.**

Any violations of the above rules can result in the loss of driving privileges for a portion of or the remainder of the school year and will have discipline consequences.

The purpose of our sale is to support the school by raising money for much needed funds that the school district cannot provide. Parking fee includes 7% sales tax. Funds raised from permit sales is under the principal's discretion and may be used to support student safety, student activities, school spirit, school supplies, scholarships, teacher leadership, professional development and training, student and faculty appreciation and recognition.
