Scholarship Program

Each year the American Legion Auxiliary Kirby Stewart Unit 24 provides \$1,000 scholarships to local Manatee County students graduating from high school. This scholarship money may be used for undergraduate studies or training in a certified trade or technical program. Monies are directly dispersed to the school an awardee is planning to attend and that school must be in the State of Florida.

Applicants are interviewed and selected according to academic record (minimum 2.5 GPA) and needs. As well as special consideration is given to students involved in school and/or community service supporting Americanism, National Security, Veterans Affairs & Rehabilitation, and/or other Children & Youth activities. Further judging criteria is associated with character, initiative/goals, and financial needs.

Preference is given to students that are members of American Legion Auxiliary Unit 24 and/or family members of American Legion Auxiliary Unit 24 members; however membership is not required to apply for this scholarship. Application deadlines are no later than **March 1**st each year. The Education Committee will further interview and select scholarship recipients by the middle of April each year.
