Senior Exemptions (Privilege)

AP/AICE/EOC/DE Courses: assigned dates and times and take priority over other exams. **No exemptions are allowed** for these courses.

Exemption Qualifications: 80% B or higher 3rd quarter **AND** an 80% B or higher 4th quarter (**not the semester average**).

Exemptions are at the discretion of the teacher.

They will follow your normal class schedule if they do NOT leave while other classes are in session.

When on campus, ALL RULES STILL APPLY.

Debt



ALL SCHOOL DEBT AND SENIOR FEES MUST BE PAID BY May 6th!
if there is still a debt after this date, students will NOT receive their cap & gown and CAN NOT WALK.



Debt will be found on their Destiny Account (not Fine Arts- they will be found via the teacher or Bookkeeper).

Graduation Requirements

- All students MUST have at least a 2.0 Unweighted GPA.
- They need to meet the 24 credit (18 for some) graduation requirements: Mandatory for ALL: 4 English, 4 Math (Alg 1 & Geo), 3 Science (Bio), 3 History (World History, US History, Gov ½ credit, Econ ½ credit) HOPE (unless waiver), Fine/Performing Arts (unless waiver), 8 Electives (unless 18 credit diploma).
- Must pass the Algebra 1 EOC, and 10th grade Reading Test (or receive a concordant score for either).
- To enter 4 year University- they MUST have 2 Foreign Languages (consecutive).
