There will be a DJ playing your songs from a playlist we created will take requests and giving away prizes.




We will crown a Winterball Prince and Princess from each grade level. Voting will take place on WEDNESDAY 1st period.

Girls Dress Code:

- 1. Dress is Semi-Formal.
- 2. Dresses may not be shorter than mid-thigh, slits may not be higher than mid-thigh.
- 3. Backless dresses may not dip below the natural waistline.
- 4. Dresses may not expose the midriff.
- 5. Cut outs, holes, and openings are not permitted.

Boys Dress Code:

- 1. Dress is Semi-Formal.
- 2. Dress shirt, tie, and dress pants are required.
- 3. Dress pants ONLY- no jeans, denim, shorts, or cargos allowed.
- 4. Cut outs, holes, and openings are not permitted.
- 5. Dress shoes are required.

*PCHS School Administration will rule on appropriateness of dress. If not in dress code, admission into the dance may be denied.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Code of Conduct:

- 1. Tickets will be sold in advance and at the door. NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.

 Ticket must be presented at the door along with a student ID or government issued ID.
- 2. PCHS Students are allowed 1 guest per student. The guest must be between the ages of 14-20. Guest must fill out a guest form and return it to student services no later than December 10th at 2:30 PM. Guest must present a ticket and form of photo identification. Guest must also abide by PCHS dress code and code of conduct or admission into the dance will be denied.
- 3. There will be no re-entry into the dance.
- 4. There is a zero tolerance policy on possession or use of alcohol, drugs or any other illegal substances at school-sponsored functions.
