- **Accelerated 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Math and 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Success Pre-Algebra Prerequisite:** Level 3 or above on the FAST, and teacher recommendation.
- **Accelerated 7<sup>th</sup> Math Prerequisite:** Level 4 or 5 on the FAST, and teacher recommendation. (*Algebra 1 Honors to Geometry path*)
