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- **Core Subjects:** All 7th graders must pass a full year of each of the four core subjects. Final Placement will be determined by state assessment scores and teacher input.
- **Advanced Course Prerequisite:** Level 3 or above on the most current required state assessment, 3.0+ GPA and applicable teacher recommendation.
- ***STEAM TEAM** (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Math) students must score a 3 or above on the FAST ELA and Math Test. STEAM students must maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA in all core courses and have an excellent background in class and homework assignments. Students must have a proven record of responsibly maintaining materials and equipment.
