What is FCCLA? FCCLA offers members the opportunity to expand their leadership potential and develop skills for life through planning, goal setting, problem solving, decision making, and interpersonal communication. FCCLA is unique among youth organizations because its programs are planned and run by members. It is the only Career and Technical in-school Student Organization (CTSO) with family as its central focus.

What does FCCLA do? BRMS FCCLA plans and leads many events that promote compassion and generosity through school and community activities. Some events we have participated in include food drives, Adopt-AFamily, making items for a memory care home, Relay for Life, and school clean-ups. We also participate in up to 31 different STAR events at the state and national level.

Who can join FCCLA? Anyone BRMS student who has taken, or plans to take, Family and Consumer Science (FCS) in 6th, 7th, or 8th grade. If you are in 8th grade and have not taken FCS yet, please talk to Ms. Diss about placement in the class next semester.

When does FCCLA meet? FCCLA has a class at BRMS that meets during 6th period. New sixth grade members will have monthly lunch-time meetings during the first semester while your child takes the 6th grade FCS course. There may be times that we need to meet before or after school, or even on the weekend to participate in competitions and community events. You will be given ample notice.
