

Parents and Students,

On Wednesday October 14<sup>th</sup>, Manatee County will administer the PSAT (preliminary SAT) to all registered 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students.

The PSAT is free of charge for all 10<sup>th</sup> grade students. 10<sup>th</sup> graders were given letters regarding the PSAT and instructions on how to opt out of testing if desired.

Any 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students wanting to take the PSAT will need to register for the test. There is a \$20.00 registration fee for 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade. Please bring cash or check (made out to PCHS) to the Testing office in the Media Center before or after school starting Wednesday September 2<sup>nd</sup>. The last day for 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students to register will be Wednesday, September 16<sup>th</sup>. Registration for 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students is limited on a first come first serve basis.

We also have all PSAT information on our school website. Please check there for further details. The PSAT will be administered on October 14<sup>th</sup> only and can also be used for the Algebra 1 EOC concordant score. All other PCHS students not participating in the PSAT will attend their normal scheduled classes on that day.
