Must maintain high school GPA of 3.0 (unweighted) and must earn a C or better in each college course or have maintained a cumulative college GPA of at least 2.5.	Must maintain high school GPA of at least 3.0 (unweighted) and maintain a college term GPA of at least 2.0.	Must maintain at least a C (2.0) average in dual enrollment courses and maintain a weighted 3.3 GPA on high school transcripts including dual enrollment course final grades.
