Dear Parent/Guardian,

Congratulations! Your child is recommended for enrollment in the Algebra I Honors mathematics course during the 2021-2022 school year. This is an outstanding achievement. Enrollment in Algebra I Honors as an eighth grader is important as it begins the high school transcript and is the foundation for all future mathematics courses. Because of this accelerated pace in mathematics, it is important that every student has a strong understanding of the standards in mathematics that are missed in moving from Seventh Grade Advanced Mathematics to Algebra I Honors.

To ensure students have the necessary skills, incoming eighth graders are highly encouraged to complete work over the summer. Students will be given a packet that includes a checklist of summer assignments located in Schoology. There will be a Schoology 8th Grade Summer Algebra I Honors Course (JOIN CODE 4RS8-RWH4-76BFQ) where students will complete lessons in folder order, watch lesson videos, notes of the lesson and a place to complete and submit work.

It is important that the assignments and the practice assessments be taken seriously. Each assignment will be completed by inputting answers under a puzzle piece. This automatically grades the assignment. Students can view their responses, and then go back and make corrections on assignments. Detailed information concerning the summer work accompanies this letter. Use the checklist as a guide for assignment completion. Assignments should be done in order in each folder and as listed on the checklist. All work is due by July 31st and must be completed in Schoology.

Remember that students are highly encouraged to complete the assignments in order to be better prepared for Algebra I Honors coursework at the beginning of the school year.

Students can receive on campus tutoring support for these assignments from 8:30-12:30 on any of the following dates:

June 15-17

June 22-24

Students will report to the main office and be directed to the classroom. Students will have the opportunity to receive free breakfast and lunch from the cafeteria as well.
