Seniors who must take an EOC will receive a separate notice of their testing date & location. If there is a conflict, a senior should attend their AICE, AP, or EOC assigned exam and work with their teacher to schedule a make-up exam.

Exemption Qualifications: Student must have a B or higher 3rd quarter AND a B or higher 4th quarter (not the semester average). No exemptions are allowed for EOC courses. Exemptions are at the discretion of the teacher.
