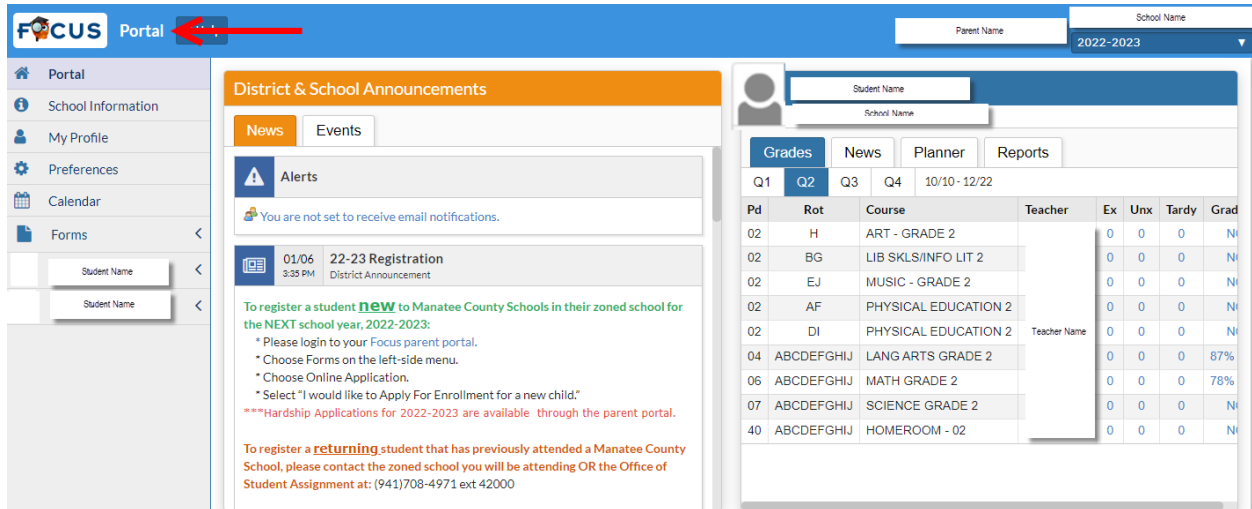


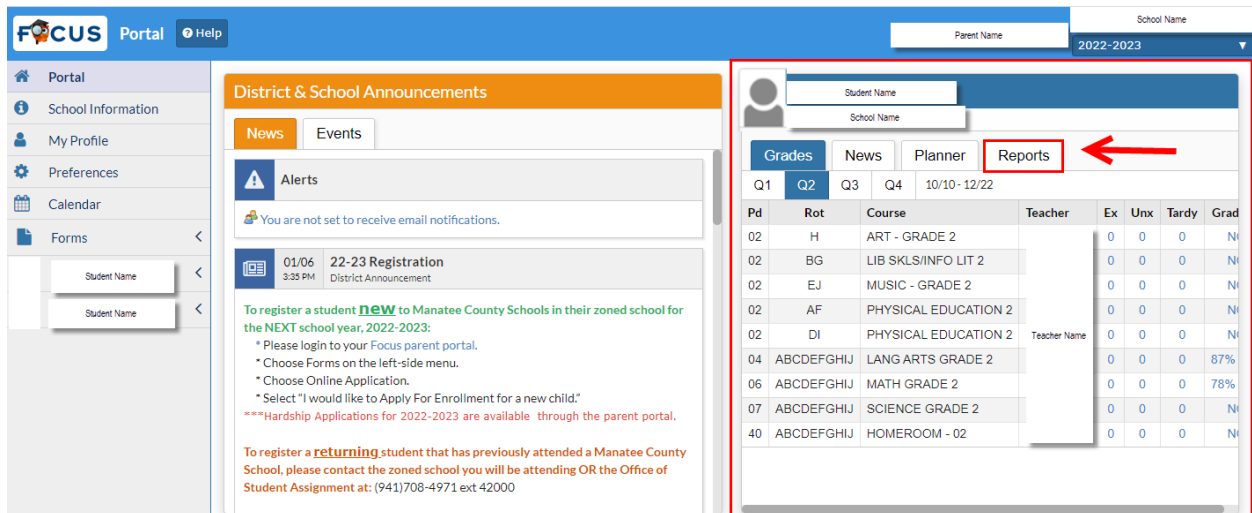
How to view your child's Report Card or Progress Report from the Parent Portal
