Homecoming Dress Code and Code of Conduct

Dress Code

- Dress is semi-formal.
- 1) Dresses, 2) skirts with blouses, 3) one-piece jumpsuits/rompers, and 4) dress pants with a belt and tucked in dress shirt and tie are appropriate options for attire.
- Clothing must cover all undergarments.
- Dress shoes are required.

Items Not Allowed

- Clothing that is excessively form-fitting or excessively baggy/oversized.
- Skirts, dresses, and jumpsuits/rompers shorter than the tips of the fingers when extended straight at one's side.
- Clothing with holes.
- Midriff exposing clothing, including cutouts and two-piece outfits that expose the midriff.
- Backless tops that drop below the navel.
- Clothing that is see through or sheer (except for the back of a blouse/dress, not to drop below the navel).
- Deep V-necks extending below the breastbone.
- Jeans, denim bottoms, shorts, cargo shorts.
- Hats
- Sunglasses
- Slides, Flip-flops

Any student who has questions about the dress code or wants to have an outfit pre-approved may bring the outfit to school administration for review.

School administrators will make the final decision on appropriateness of student attire. If a student pushes the limits of the dress code, they risk being turned away from the dance.

Conduct

- BRHS students must present a ticket and ID at the door. Tickets will be sold in advance at school. No admittance after 9:30PM.
- The dress code must be followed prior to entering and for the duration of the dance.
- Once a student leaves the dance, they may not return.
- Dancing must remain appropriate and safe. Promiscuous dancing, slam dancing, and rowdiness will not be tolerated.
- Chairs are not allowed on the dance floor.
- **BRHS students may bring ONE dance guest. Please see the REQUIRED guest form on the back of this paper. Guest forms are due to Mrs. Gonzales by the end of the school day (2:35pm) on Friday, October 14, 2022 (NO EXCEPTIONS). Do not turn it in to anyone else. No late forms will be accepted. Guests must also abide by the BRHS Homecoming Dress Code and Code of Conduct, or they will not be admitted to the dance.**
- There is ZERO tolerance for possession or use of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or other illegal substances at all school-sponsored functions. Students caught with or under the influence of any of these substances will be subject to school discipline consequences and will be remanded to law enforcement.
- Any student who does not abide by the above Dress Code and Code of Conduct may be immediately dismissed from the dance.
- NO REFUNDS for tickets purchased will be issued.
- Braden River High School is not responsible for any thefts or damage to personal items.
