Technology Reminders



A reminder to all students and parents. Bringing your own device to Nolan Middle School is a privilege. We ask that all students keep electronics to include cell phones, tablets, laptops, ear buds, head phones and other technology components in their back pack at all times. Ear buds and headphones are not to be worn in the hallways. Also any technology use in the classroom must be approved by the teacher. If students have technology in their backpacks they are responsible for taking care of their backpacks and technology.

Devices must be securely placed in the backpack. Students carrying phones in their pockets can have them taken away by staff. If a device is taken away parents will need to come to the school to retrieve the phone. If a student needs to use their cell phone for any reason, they must ask a teacher or staff member.
