

UNIFORM POLICY Palmetto Elementary School 2023-2024

Palmetto Elementary School has a mandatory uniform policy. **Students are required to wear a Palmetto Elementary Uniform to school each day.** The Palmetto Elementary Uniform Policy is as follows:

<u>TOPS</u>

Shirts should be a solid polo style shirt or button-down collared shirt in white, red, black, or blue. Long or short sleeve is acceptable.

Palmetto Elementary t-shirts may be worn on the last school day in a week.

<u>Sweatshirts must be solid uniform color</u> (red, white, black, or blue). Heavy winter jackets to be worn outside may be any color and students will be required to take them off in the building(s).

BOTTOMS

Navy blue, black, or khaki slacks, shorts, capris, or jumpers. Dark navy or black jeans are also permitted.

Students may NOT wear jeans with rips or holes, sweatpants, jeggings (yoga pants), or cutoffs.

Shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers must be fingertip length.

<u>SHOES</u>

Shoes must have a closed heel and closed toe. Sandals, thong-type shoes, shoes with cleats, shoes with thick platform soles, high heels, shoes with wheels, and Crocs[™] are NOT allowed. Sneakers with socks must be worn for P.E.

Hair should be neat and not cause a distraction to the learning environment. Barrettes and ponytail scrunchies, etc. are acceptable. Students, however, may be asked to remove any items in the hair that are costume like or distracting (For example, headbands with animal ears).

Students may not wear sunglasses, hats, visors, bandanas, or other head apparel; known gang-related symbols on any clothing, accessories, or jewelry.
