NOMINATIONS STILL BEING ACCEPTED FOR RENAMING OF NEW HIGH SCHOOL

(Bradenton, FL – February 11, 2019) Nominations for renaming North River High School are still being accepted by the School District's office of Communications, Family and Community Engagement. The School Board initiated the renaming process during a workshop held on Tuesday, August 21, 2018, after a substantial number of citizens mounted a campaign to have the name changed to Parrish High School.

The high school is currently under construction on the southeast corner of Erie Road and Martha Road near Parrish and it is scheduled to open in August 2019.
