(22 votes) McGraw Hill said they would split the book into volumes. IT also stated that they would open the Google Docs for Savvas. Technology is still a concern with Savvas. Pros for McGraw Hill for the committee: There won't be as big of a learning curve. If you bring a new teacher in, they won't have to pull from different resources. Fully integrated with Schoology. Carry the data from each grade so that teachers can track the standards. The vocabulary of the text was easier to navigate. Integrated learning tool.
