Dear Candidates and Parents,

Thank you for your interest in the Braden River High School Dance Team. As a member, you can show your Pirate pride through performances, competitions, and community events. The qualifications to become a member are as follows:

- ✓ Maintain a 2.0 minimum GPA
- ✓ Have pep and enthusiasm
- ✓ Enjoy performing & be ready to work hard
- ✓ Ready to assume the responsibility of representing BRHS

Dancing is a rewarding experience, but it is also a large time commitment and can be costly. This is a competitive team that requires earnest efforts and sincere dedication. You may want to experience all of high school but when it's time to work, we expect dancers to be READY! EXPECT TO LIMIT THE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES, SPORTS, ETC. Be aware of these facts as you prepare to take on the responsibilities of representing Braden River High School as a BLACK PEARL DANCER.

Parent Responsibilities:

- Read the entire packet and be certain that you fully understand the rules and regulations that govern the Black Pearls and/or have asked the coach (via email above) to clarify any parts you do not understand.
- Make sure that each form has been filled out completely and correctly.
- Attend the mandatory parent/student meeting if your dancer is chosen
- Volunteer for fundraisers, events, etc. throughout the year

Dancer Responsibilities:

- Maintain a 2.0 GPA
- Represent BRHS in a positive way
- Arrive on time to dance team functions (including practices) with the correct clothing and shoes, along with any other required materials

- Attend all practices and performances unless excused (contact coach with any conflicts)
- Participate in team activities, fundraisers, and other events
- Dancers will be expected to perform at football games and basketball games as well as Pep rallies, Basketball halftimes, "Yes, We Can Dance,"
 "Dancing with the Pirates," and competitions.

ATHLETIC Paperwork & Insurance

- School Insurance must be purchased and form turned in PRIOR to participation.
- Current Athletes of BRHS who have tried out for 2023-2024 or participated in a sport this year do not need to purchase additional sports insurance sports. However, it must be repurchased in Aug 2024 prior to first performance.
- Students who are new to BRHS or the athletics program MUST purchase \$25 insurance (Checks made out to Braden River High School) or paid online to cover them for the audition process. This will also cover you for camp and summer rehearsals if you make the team.
- Every student who makes the team, they will then need to re-purchase the full \$50 insurance for the 2022-2023 school year in August.

- Friday, April 19th, 2024: FINAL Auditions: Begin at 4:00pm, BRHS Gym/Dance Room (likely done by 5pm)

WHAT TO WEAR:

- Dancers must wear form fitting dance/workout attire for the duration of audition week in addition to lightweight sneakers or dance shoes.
- Tights or leggings must be worn with shorts.
- No jeans, chewing gum, jewelry, or street clothes will be accepted.
- Final Audition Attire: Same as rehearsal attire—BLACK ONLY.
 Candidates that wear dance shorts MUST wear tights!
 Candidates may not audition with bare legs.
- Returning dancers MAY NOT wear old dance team wear to rehearsals or auditions.

 - c. Stretching Skills—splits, needles, heel stretches, scorpions, back contortions
 - d. Jumps/Leaps—Axels, firebirds, toe touches, c-jumps, grand jete leaps, turning discs, tilt jumps, calypsos
- 4. A routine will be taught and practiced by current Black Pearl Captains during the week of auditions, this routine will be a large portion of your assessment at tryouts. There will be a video link given at tryouts to practice at home ON Wednesday
- 5. NO Spectators: Rehearsals and auditions are CLOSED to the public.

Audition requirements:

You will be judged based on the following—

- ✓ Audition Routine (Showmanship, Projection, Technique, Memory, Overall Performance)
- ✓ Short Kick/Leap Combination
- ✓ Execution of technical dance skills section
- ✓ Turning in all forms by the deadline (first day of auditions)
- ✓ Report Card / GPA / REFERENCES FROM TEACHERS AND COACHES (Florida athletes are required to maintain a 2.0 GPA)
- ✓ Punctuality and proper audition attire at ALL rehearsals and final audition.
- ✓ Maintaining a positive attitude that promotes teamwork and respect for other audition candidates.
- ✓ Your audition begins once you enter on the first day of rehearsals, PLEASE
 be aware, though there is a final audition, dancers will be evaluated
