## **COMMUNITY**

Braden River High School is located in Manatee County (population 340,000+). BRHS opened in August of 2005 with 9th and 10th grades in a community of both skilled and professional families. The first graduating class participated in a commencement ceremony in June 2008.

## SCHOOL DATA AND ACCREDITATION

BRHS is a comprehensive high school with an enrollment of over 1800 9th-12th grade students. Braden River is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

BRHS is a wall-to-wall academy high school currently consisting of the following:

- Arts & Communication Technology Academy
- Business & International Studies Academy
- Engineering Design & Leadership Academy
- Science Technology & Health Academy

The four academies were evaluated by the National Career Academy Coalition. All four academies met the requirements to be recognized as Model Status Academies in 2012 and this status has been maintained during the reaccreditation process completed in 2020.

## **ACADEMIC CALENDAR**

The school year is divided into two eighteen-week semesters. One-half credit is awarded at the end of each semester for every course passed with a D or higher.

## **GRADE WEIGHTING**

All grades earned in Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment courses receive an additional quality point when calculating the weighted grade point average.

Honors courses receive an additional half quality point. Class Rank is based on a student's cumulative weighted GPA.

## **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

All students must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA, earn at least 24 credits, and meet the State of Florida's standardized testing requirements to receive a standard high school diploma.

The Class of 2024 is required to pass the Florida Standards Assessment in English Language Arts or earn a concordant score on the ACT, SAT or CLT. These students must also pass the Algebra 1 End-of-Course Assessment or earn a concordant score on ACT, SAT, PSAT, Geometry End-of-Course Assessment or CLT

Students also have the opportunity to earn additional merit accolades including the Merit Diploma Designation, Scholar Diploma Designation, Silver Seal of Biliteracy, and Gold Seal of Biliteracy.


