## Healthy Meals

Meals are planned to offer a variety of vitamins and minerals and also meet calorie, fat and sodium requirements.

Low fat/free milk, fresh fruit, vegetables and 100% juice are provided every day.

A La Carte offerings vary by school and all items meet Smart Snack regulations.

To be considered a meal at breakfast or lunch students must choose:

- 1/2 cup fruit or vegetable
- 2 other components

Components include protein, grains, milk, fruits, and vegetables

At breakfast a student may choose up to 2 grains or up to 2 proteins or 1 grain/1 protein to complete the meal. If a student doesn't select a meal A La Carte prices will be applied.

## Food Allergies & Diet Modifications

The 9 major food allergens are monitored when students purchase a meal. To have a food allergen added to your student's account or for any other needed diet modification please contact the school nurse. If your student attends a CEP schools, allergens are not monitored at breakfast. Food ingredient information can be found on our website or by contacting our office.
