


Accessing IXL via MySDMC SSO

- 1.) Visit the MySDMC SSO Portal:




- 2.) Open your web browser and go to the MySDMC SSO Portal.



- 3.) Log In:
- 4.) Enter the SDMC-assigned username and password provided by the school district. If you don't have these credentials, please contact your child's school for assistance.

Navigate to the Dashboard:


- 5.) Once logged in, you will see the MySDMC SSO dashboard. This dashboard provides access to various educational tools and resources.
- 6.) Find and Click on the IXL Icon:




- 7.) Look for the IXL icon on the dashboard. It might be listed under educational resources or apps. Click on the IXL icon to be redirected to the IXL website.

8.) Select the Subject:


9.) On the IXL website, you will see different subjects listed. For 5th-grade students, select Math, Science, or Language Arts



10.) Choose the Grade Level:




11.) Ensure that the grade level is set to 5th grade. You can usually find this option in the subject menu or settings.

12.) Under each subject tab (Math, Science, Language Arts), click on Skills.



13.) Select the Appropriate Standards:

14.) For Math, click on Florida's B.E.S.T. Standards: Math.

15.) For Science, click on Florida Statewide Science Assessments.

16.) For Language Arts, click on Florida's B.E.S.T. Standards: Language Arts.

17.) Start Learning:

Your child can now start practicing skills in Math, Science, and Language Arts according to the specified standards. IXL provides interactive questions and activities tailored to their grade level.
