

SAC minutes from August 22, 2024

Meeting was called to order at 6:56pm.

SAC Board members were introduced.

The minutes from May 2024 were read and accepted.

- Motion to accept: Giselle DeLucia
- 2nd Motion to accept: Amanda Boyd

1) Purpose of SAC reviewed by Giselle DeLucia

2) Open SAC positions and required demographics were discussed

- attendees notified that elections for open positions will be held during September meeting

3) Review of School Grade

- BAH Elementary maintained School Grade of "A"
- During '23-'24 school year, BAH Elementary received "School of Excellence" designation
- Dr. Rio explained to attendees how School Grade is determined
- Writing will be added to evaluated skills for School Grade determination for '24-'25
- Dr. Rio reviewed the SIP goals for '24-'25

4) Student Population Size Discussion

- 1 New student was added after enrollment was frozen
- Specifics were explained by Dr. Rio
- Current enrollment is 1,368 students and enrollment is frozen

5) Future planning

- BAH will become a dual campus, K-8, or possibly PK-8, school
 - Current campus will serve K (or PK) - 3rd grade students
- Dr. Rio will serve as Executive Principal for both campuses (first for district)
- New Campus (a.k.a., "North Community Middle School")
 - expected to serve 4th - 8th grade students
 - concept pictures, design elements, and benefits presented by Dr. Rio
- Question regarding student safety in the new campus:
 - Will students in middle school grades be separated from students in elementary grades on the new campus?
 - Dr. Rio explained that the current plan is to keep the children in the middle school grades downstairs, and the younger students upstairs
 - Currently anticipating a decision about which grade levels will open the new campus will be made sometime in or by September
 - Additional questions regarding logistics were asked but answers are not available at this time
