

Harvey SAC Meeting Minutes

Date: October 17, 2024

Meeting called to order: 6:16pm

1. Jim Wailes read the minutes from the September meeting and they were approved
2. Dr. Rio reviewed current steps at Harvey
 - a. Hurricane Milton Outcomes
 - i. 700+ individuals provided shelter during storm along with many pets
 - ii. Damage to Harvey campus was minimal
 - Learning cottages fared very well
 - A few small pieces were lost off of portables and a small amount of damage to fencing
 - A few Harvey families suffered significant damage to their homes
 - iii. Make-up dates still unknown at the time of the meeting
 - b. New Campus information meetings to be held for 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade families
 - i. 5th Grade information meeting nights scheduled for 10/28 and 10/30, both meetings scheduled to start at 6:30pm in the Harvey cafeteria.
 - ii. If all 5th grade students go to new Harvey campus for 6th grade an issue would result potential issues so a selection process will take place to determine which 5th grade students from Harvey will be able to attend 6th grade at the new Harvey campus and the current intent is to provide answers regarding decisions before Thanksgiving.
 - iii. Information meetings for current 3rd and 4th grade student's families will be held on 11/4 and 11/7, in the Harvey cafeteria at 6:30.
 - c. Data meetings with Teachers
 - i. Data meetings were originally scheduled for the weeks of 10/14 and 10/21, but are being moved due to disruptions resulting from Hurricane Milton, and will resume next week (10/28)
 - ii. Parent question: As a result of storm disruptions, Hillsborough County has pushed back the end of their first semester by 1 week. Will Manatee Co. or Harvey be doing that?

- Dr. Rio answered: Report cards are now required to be completed by 10/25, rather than the original date.

3. Renewal Referendum Presentation

- a. Dr. Rio provided a presentation detailing the referendum for Millage renewal that will be on the November ballot

4. Other

- a. Color Splash – kick off on Nov 8th (Friday), walk on Nov 22nd (Friday right before break) (kind of a walk-a-thon, kids are asked to get sponsors, kids get colored chalk, fire dept hooks up hoses and foam and kids go through foam and then get sprayed off)
- b. Transformation was supposed to be Tuesday and teachers have been asked to vote on new dates and it looks likely that it will be when students return from Spring break
- c. Parent question: Will Harvey main campus have VPK next year?
 - i. Dr. Rio answered that this is not known yet.
- d. Parent question: If a family is rezoned, can they be “grandfathered” in for new Harvey campus?
 - i. Dr. Rio answered that it is not known yet how these situations will be handled.
