- 1. Using black or blue ink, please print the information requested on the attached form.
- 2. Write a standard five-paragraph essay. This essay is a very important part of your application. It assists the selection committee in knowing you as an individual and it allows us to assess your ability to communicate through writing. It should <u>not</u> be longer than two pages. Your final essay <u>must be in ink</u> and in your handwriting.

<u>Prompt:</u> Discuss an activity, interest, experience, or achievement in your life (this could be a book, movie, or an activity or experience at work, home, or school) that has been particularly meaningful for you.

- 3. Both the applying student and a parent should review all pages of this application and provide signatures on Page 4 of this application.
- 4. Acceptance into the PHS Cambridge AICE Program is contingent upon a student's ELA and Math FAST testing results (or other standardized testing scores), grade point average, transcripts of course history, discipline record, and successful completion of the application and essay.
- 5. Please submit this application to the front desk at Palmetto High School (Attention: Jennifer Little) or by email to <u>Littlej@manateeschools.net</u> by Friday, Jan. 10, 2025.
- 6. Students not currently zoned for Palmetto High School must ALSO apply for School Choice during the School Choice Window which ends in January of 2025. The School Choice Application process will be done exclusively online. Parents will access and submit the School Choice Application via the Focus Parent Portal online. Go to the "Special Programs" option and choose "AICE." This means that to apply for School Choice, his/her parent must have an active Parent Portal account.

If your student lives in the Palmetto High School zone, then you do not need to fill out the School Choice Application in the FOCUS Parent Portal.

- 7. If you are coming from a Manatee County public middle or high school that does not use FOCUS grade reporting system, please attach a copy of your most recent standardized test scores and a transcript showing your grades last year and first semester of this year.
- 8. Welcome packets/yard signs/acceptance decisions are usually delivered during the second or third week of February. Please be patient.

- 5. I agree to take all the AICE exams I am registered for at Palmetto High School as scheduled. I understand that the University of Cambridge, not Palmetto High School, determines the AICE Exam Schedule for each subject each year. The AICE Exam Schedule includes exams administered during the months of April, May, and June. There are not retake dates for these exams until the following November.
