Journalism is a big responsibility, but it is also very rewarding.

Deadlines are very important in Journalism, so your ability to complete your application and submit it by the deadline is part of showing your dedication to being on staff. All forms must be completely filled out and returned to Mrs. Reid-Spears in the media center (Yearbook) or Mrs. DuBois in Room 827 (Newspaper) on or before **Thursday, March 11th**. The Journalism staff will be announced after all applications have been reviewed. A list of approved students will be submitted to the guidance department. We do not sign your registration forms. We look forward to receiving your Journalism application and appreciate your interest in the program.
