**4. 1Mill4Manatee Presentation by Sharon Scarbrough**

a. Auditor report by video stated today's budget should be \$5 million short but we  
are \$24 Million ahead; shows fiscal responsibility

b. 1 Mill will bring in \$33 million; amounts to \$17 per household per month; to be  
used for people not buildings; 1 Mill = \$1 per \$1000 in value

c. Money goes mostly to support staff and teachers not administration

d. School Board will add 30 minutes a day of instruction which equals an additional  
year from K-12

e. Sarasota has added the 1 Mill for 16 years; Pinellas has a ½ mill

f. Teachers, students and jobs benefit

g. Manatee County is below Sarasota and Pinellas Counties in salaries for teachers, principals and bus drivers; losing trained staff to those higher paying counties; extra money will close the gap

h. The breakdown of money is as follows: teachers 56%, staff 8%, STEM/CTE 16%, School Administration 6%, Charter Schools 15%

i. Referendum vote is being held in March so the money will be available at the start of the next school year; money will be available July 1st

j. after school care money is paying for the referendum

k. ½ penny sales tax pays for buildings and technology; impact fees have no impact on paying people

l. need SAC to speak to people; pass the word

m. WeManatee.net – informs on things going on in Manatee County

n. February 20<sup>th</sup> is voter registration deadline

o. simple majority will pass referendum
