1. **Call to Order:** Meeting called to order by SAC Vice Chair/Secretary-Kim Stroud at 6:04pm

2. **Approval of Minutes:** Edit to the minutes to reflect voting member Jolanda Brewer as present. Motion made to approve January 2022 minutes by Jolanda Brewer
Seconded by Heidi LeRoy..No discussion requested. Motion approved unanimously.

3. **Principal's Report: SEE ATTACHED POWERPOINT**

School Projected Grade: PYP Projected school grade on benchmarks would be an A school (62%. Achievement levels were ahead of many other schools. Learning gains 60% showing gains. L25 showing gains is 61%-this is a significant increase from previous years. Considering COVID has limited some collaboration, this is a significant gain.

MYP: ELA is 67% showing gains; Math is 76% proficient; and Acceleration is 82%. Social Studies...99% of our students show proficiency. 622 Total=A school

Combined: Projected to be an A School. We were 588 as a school grade last year. We are projected to be 622.

• **Spring Pictures:** March 7th. PYP class pictures outside. Eagle in the courtyard is getting cleaned so it will look nice in the pictures.

• **Literacy Parent University Night and ESOL Night:** New to Johnson. **March 10th,** Parents can come in for a literacy night for parents so they are prepared to help kids during breaks on reading and continued learning. Literacy activities for students and strategies for parents. Prizes and Kona Ice. ESOL Night will be happening at this night as well.

• **Spring Break (March 14-18)**

- **FSA Testing Windows:** See the attached document for dates

- **Recruitment:** We have 9 in Kindergarten; 2 left in 1s, 2nd and 3rd are full; 4th has 2 spots left; 5th grade: over capacity (District allow a small number of over capacity); 6th grade-10 spaces remaining; 7th: 1 student available slot; 8th grade has 9 spots open. Never have we been this close to capacity in Feb. Scheduling another Discover Johnson to attempt to fill these vacancies.

QUESTION: Would you choose to go over if you had the numbers? District administration allows it to go over a slight bit (4-6 kids over but not known until 10 day count). Doesn't expect to be well over capacity like some of the other schools. Mr. Losada does not want portables.

- **Safety:** Rumors about SRO's that the Sheriff and Superintendent are discussing the use of guardians in elementary and SRO's in middle school. Mr. Losada has not heard anything regarding this from the District Administration. Fencing: We are getting a roll gate on the East side by building 6. No definite date of when it will be installed, but Mr. Losada is connected with the Director of Risk Management

- **SAC Budget:** Received \$768 from teachers on campus who did not spend their LEAD money at Office Depot. Mr. Losada will be coming to SAC with a recommendation, likely for Boot Camps for proficiency.

- **Future Meetings:** March, April and May. To be a 5 star school, we will have had 9-10 meetings. In the past, we have elected not to meet in March due to Spring Break. Jen Russell made a motion to cancel the March SAC Meeting, Heidi LeRoy seconded the motion. No discussion. Unanimous approval. March 2022 SAC meeting is canceled. The April and May meetings will be held onsite in the multi-purpose room unless otherwise notified.

- **Families on Campus:** Lunch Bunch, Volunteers, Activities. PTO has had volunteers on campus doing the candy grams for Valentines Day. Volunteers on campus for Renaissance. Mr. Losada is going to establish a sign up, rsvp, for lunch to manage the crowds. There will be limits to the number of parents who can come on campus, but it's a step forward to bring more parents on campus.

Question: Not advertised yet, but Mr.Losada will be moving in the direction of parent/teacher conferences. MYP Parents should contact the Teacher to establish a conference. Middle School parents should coordinate with Administration so all MYP teachers can be present. **QUESTION:** When should students hear they are accepted to Johnson? They are in the mail this week and next if there is an opening. .
