The School Board of Manatee County has scheduled an Emergency Board Meeting for 2 p.m. on Friday, August 14, 2020.

The Emergency Meeting is being called to reconsider Policy 8450 - Control of Casual-contact Communicable Diseases. The version of Policy 8450 approved by the School Board at last night's meeting mandates all employees, visitors, and students wear a face mask that covers the nose and mouth while on school property, facilities, transportation vehicle, including school buses and/or engaged in school activities.

The meeting will be held in the Board chambers at the School Support Center, located at 215 Manatee Avenue West, in Bradenton.
