- Discussed how we received our accreditation over the summer, so our school can give the graduating seniors accredited diplomas.

New Business:

Elections:

- Nadia Wood was nominated and elected as chairperson
- Jodie Hyvonen was nominated and elected for vice chairperson

School Improvement Plan (SIP)-

- Ms. Bieber discussed the SIP for the 2021-22 school year
- Major goal is to get our school to an A grade
 - Focus on lower quartile
 - English Language Arts FSA: 5% increase learning gains in bottom quartile, and 3% overall increase
 - Math EOC: 3% increase in students above a level 3, and 12% increase learning gains in lower quartile
 - Biology EOC: 5% increase from state's 70% average learning gains
 - US History: 5% pass rate increase
 - 100% of staff receives training to support student skills to help reduce discipline referrals by 5%, and decrease the number of students at risk for graduating by 5%
- The SIP was approved

Referendum Update:

- Upcoming vote regarding millage tax update
- Because of this tax, our school has been able to afford better technology, and pay teachers to tutor many of our students
- Increased instructional by 30 minutes daily, better starting pay for teachers, STEM Funding
