Manatee County Y Behavior Management Policy

FOR YOUTH DEVELOPMENT
FOR HEALTHY LIVING
FOR SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

It is the goal of the Manatee County Family YMCA, Inc. to guide children and teens in becoming caring, honest, responsible, and cooperative individuals. The Y uses only positive behavior management techniques to increase a participant's self-esteem by helping them become aware of and responsible for their own actions. It is important for participants to learn to respect themselves as well as the rights and feelings of others.

When a conflict arises concerning the rights of other people and/or property, our goal is to work with each participant individually to solve the problem through effective communication and logical consequences. Other behavior management techniques may include redirecting behavior, removal from a particular activity, area or group and parent consultation will all be used in situations where conflicts continue to arise.

Depending on the severity and frequency of conflicts such as, fighting, bullying, inappropriate language, destruction of property, lack of regard for rules, or the possession of inappropriate toys (i.e. play guns, swords, or other weapons), a participant may be suspended or expelled from the program immediately and the parent/guardian will be called to pick up their child/teen (unless severity or repetition of incident(s) requires other action as determined by the Program Director). Otherwise, the following behavior management procedures will be followed:


- Verbal communication will occur as necessary between staff, child and parent/guardian.
- Program Director will be notified to review the situation.
- Written notice (Parent Communication Letter) will be given to the parent/guardian and must be signed by both parent/guardian and Program Director after careful review and discussion of incident.
- The participant may be suspended and/or terminated depending on the severity & frequency of the incident(s).
- A conference may be scheduled with the Program Director and parent/guardian before the child may return to the program. At which time, a Behavior Management Plan will be discussed, written and reviewed with the child.

It is at the sole discretion of the Manatee County Family YMCA, Inc. to determine inappropriate behavior by its participants, or the participant's parent or guardian, and thus reserves the right to dismiss any participant, at any time, for any inappropriate behavior.

If a participant is terminated from the program, enrollment in any future Y programs may be compromised and subject to review. Refunds for registration, program fees, or deposits that have been already paid will not be given.

Failure to disclose all pertinent information about your child/teen can lead to termination from the program.

Good communication and solid boundaries will ensure a well-structured YMCA environment that allows each participant the opportunity to develop self-control and respect for themselves and others.
