1. **Call to Order and Welcome:** A virtual meeting of the Anna Maria School Advisory Committee was held on Feb 10, 2022. David Zaccagnino called the meeting to order at 3:46 pm. Ivory Graham will record the minutes for this meeting.
2. **Review and Approval November, 2021 SAC minutes.** A review was done of the minutes from the Nov 2021 SAC meeting. A motion was made to approve the minutes by Ashley Chiles and seconded by Chris Rudacille. All members present voiced approval.

Discussion was also had on the current condition of the caboose. It was reported that it is rusting to the point of causing safety concerns. Suggestions were made that various community groups be contacted regarding ways to possibly restore it. Janae Rudacille volunteered to head this project.
8. **Safety Update:** Officer LaBranche shared information of the new Drug Awareness Program (L.E.A.D) that will be used with 5th grade students beginning next school year.
9. **Other:** A golf tournament will be held as the yearly fundraiser instead of a gala. More information will be announced. It was also suggested that more funds might be raised if more information is shared regarding how PTO funds are being used to benefit the school.
