

Anna Maria Elementary School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes
November 30,2023

1. Call to Order: A meeting of the Anna Maria Elementary School School Advisory Council was held on November 30, 2023. Mr. Masiello called to meeting to order at 3:50 p.m.
2. Introductions
3. Membership- Kristi Kliebert is unable to continue as a voting member of SAC due to meeting conflicts.
4. Review and approve September 28, 2023 SAC minutes: A review was made of the SAC minutes for the last meeting. It was determined no updates were needed. Pidge Barreda motioned that the minutes be approved. Motion seconded by Jenny Moore. All members present approved the motion.
5. Funds added to SAC budget in the amount of \$1,498.58 were funds remaining from teacher lead money needing to be spent on supplies. A motion was made by Mr. Masiello to continue to spend the funds on school supplies, Pidge Barreda seconded the motion, all members voted to utilize the funds for school supplies.
6. School Choice window was reviewed and will be open from November 27th to December 20th.
7. Teacher Allocations: The current ESE teacher allocation is shared with Stewart Elementary School and has been brought back up to a full time position at each school. The position will be posted for hire in order to have a full time ESE teacher at each school.
8. Upcoming district and state assessment windows were reviewed, the state will be coming out with new cut scores in December for the FAST assessment.
9. Campus Upgrades: The Media Center upgrade has been completed, new furniture and technology installed. The auditorium has had a new sound system installed and new TV monitors will also be installed in the coming weeks.
10. Safety Update: A Table Top drill was held on campus today with law enforcement, fire dept and district security personnel. The drill was to review scenarios in the event of an active intruder on our campus.
11. Guy Harvey Program Updates: The 2 million dollar state appropriations grant is in process, the district is submitting plans to the state for the first million to be spent by the end of this school year. The second million dollars will have a 3 year timeline to be spent, plans are forthcoming.
12. Upcoming events hosted by PTO and school based events were reviewed.
