Enrollment/Unit Allocation Update

- No current update on the request for a second, full-time guardian.
- Student enrollment for 2023-2024 is projected around 1,100 but is expected to fluctuate given pending student commitments to other area schools and ongoing area construction. Current staffing can absorb additional students.

FAST Testing Update

- The following goals for the Florida Assessment for Student Thinking (FAST) were set for the school year:
 - By May 2023, 78% of students will be proficient in ELA
 - 4th graders met the above goal.
 - 3rd-5th combined reached 75% proficiency.
 - By May 2023, 85% of students will be proficient in Math
 - 3rd graders met the above goal.
 - 5th graders met the above goal.
 - 3rd-5th combined reached 83% proficiency.
 - By May 2023, 75% of our students will be proficient in Science
 - Still in progress
 - The chart below highlights the gains made from the 1st to the 3rd FAST test.

- New Manatee County schools
 - 10 new schools being constructed in Manatee county over the next five years, the majority in the Lakewood Ranch area.
 - Biggest and highest priority project is the K-8 school near Star Farms on Uihlein and Academic, projected to open August 2025.
 - First year will be only K-5
 - 26-27 will add 6th
 - 27-28 will add 7th
 - 28-29 will add 8th
 - Board will begin to re-draw boundaries for zoning ASAP, during the construction phase.
 - New elementary school planned by DeSoto Speedway within 4-6 years.
 - New high school projected to be finished within 3-4 years by Premiere Sports. It will be a very large school, alleviating LWR HS enrollment.
