4. Unit Allocation/Student Enrollment

- a. Current enrollment = 1,238 students
- b. Project last year to be at and staffed for 1,100 (1-18 and 1-22 for class size in FL). We're funded at 1-19 and 1-23).
- c. Gullett was fully staffed at both ratios at start of year.
- d. Opening teaching positions in 2nd, 3rd, and 4th next week. IF teachers are hired some students may be impacted as classrooms are balanced.
 - i. There are 268 4th graders currently
- e. There will also be one teacher aid position added in 4th grade.

5. New Schools Update

- a. District push for new construction in LWR and Parrish area
- b. New K-8 school starting in the next couple of months (on Uhlein and Academic Ave.)
 - i. There will be a re-zoning project starting soon and there will be students re-zoned from Gullett to the new school.
 - ii. May enact the grandfather clause but transportation is not on the district
 - iii. School choice may not be an option depending on enrollment size
 - iv. Goal is to open August 2025 – elementary (K-5)
 - v. August 2026 – 6th opens
 - vi. New high school – target 5-7 years next to Premiere complex
 - vii. Target 10-14 years – elementary further east by the speedway
